HUGHSON, Calif.—Plushanski Oscar Kong-et, a young bull bred by Plushanski Farms, Kutztown, has been selected for sampling in the young sire proving program of Landmark Genetics, an International artificial breeding company.

His semen has just been released for use in herds on official DHIA test throughout the

United States.

As a member of Landmark Genetics' Genetic Opportunity "GO" Program, Kong is undergoing testing. He has successfully passed his health tests and the goal now is to get a minimum of 50 daughters milking in 40 herds across the U.S. for a high reliability on his first proof.

Kong is a son of Art-Acres Ned

Boy Oscar-et TL and Plushanski Cleitus Farci. Farci is VG 87, excellent mammary, with records to 39,680M, 4.6% 1,826F and 3.6% 1,425P.

'Incredi-bull' Ballistic Brothers At Rodeo



BUCK (Lancaster Co.) — Billed as the biological brothers bent on brutalizing bullriders, three Simbrah bulls from Tulsa, Okla. are coming to the Buck Tractor Pull Stadium for Dave Martin's Championship Rodeo on Monday, May 29 at 2 p.m. and 7 p.m.

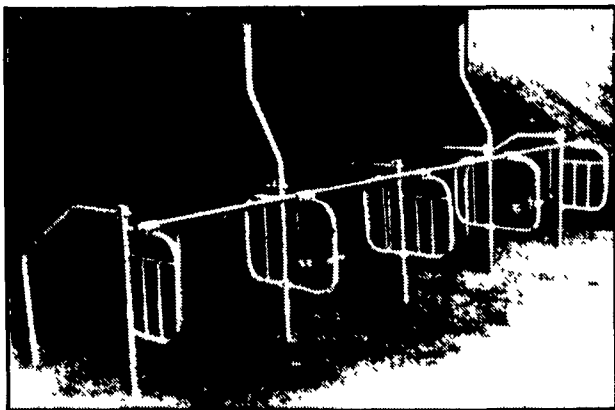
Recently, the "Incredi-bulls," affectionately known as the Ballistic Brothers for starting out like projectiles, blasted through the April Bullride Mania in Harrisburg. They were introduced to the audience as "hard to handle." The brutalizing brothers are the result of breeding a polled purebred Brahma bull to a herd of Simmental cows. Their names? Iron Man, Hang Man, and Demolition Man.

By the way — Iron Man was named the American Professional Rodeo Association's "Best Bucking Bull of the Finals" and APRA Bucking Bull of the Year. His career record is out 118 times, ridden successfully only 4. The four rides were scored 85, 83, 84, and 88. He was purchased in Ft. Worth at the Cowtown Coliseum Bucking Stock Sale for \$8,000 in the fall of 1993.

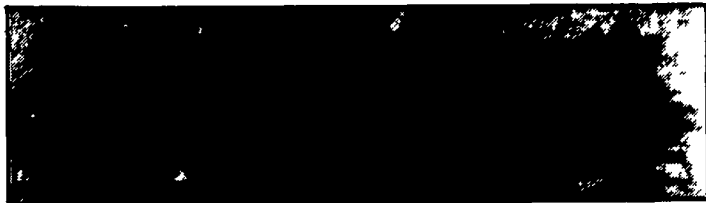
Iron Man's half brother Hangman was purchased in October 1994 at the bucking stock sale in Glen Rose, Texas for \$3,500. The third bull, Demolition Man, was purchased in March 1995 in Huntingdon, W.Va. for \$10,000.

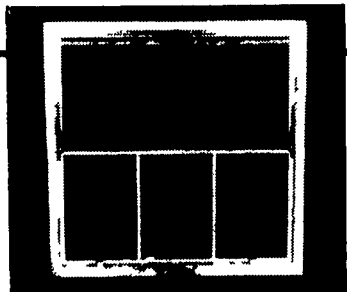
Lapp Comfort Tie Stall

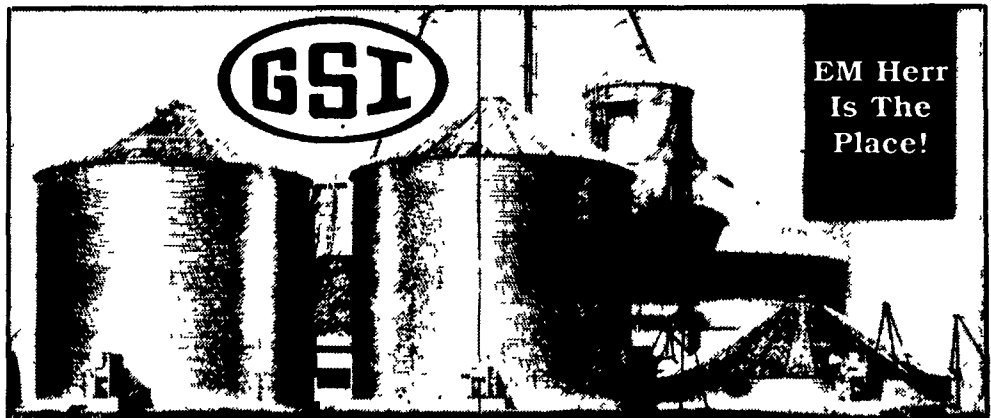
