

# Liquid Fuels Tax Refund

(Continued from Page A1)

The refund is not a gift to farmers, it is a matter of the state returning taxes paid in that were not owed.

To collect their money, farmers must make a claim every year. With each claim must be either the actual receipts, copies of the receipts, or a statement from a fuel

dealer showing the purchaser's name, the date, the number of gallons purchased and verification that the state tax was paid.

Until a claim is made for two consecutive years, the state will not automatically mail a claim form to a farmer who is owed money.

It is up to the farmer to seek out the claim form, which are available from the Board of Finance and Revenue, 500 C Finance Building,

The period for which taxes are refunded coincide with the state fiscal year, which runs from July 1 to June 30.

For those who have made claims for at least the past two years, forms are to be mailed out automatically on June 16.

If a claim form is not received within a reasonable time from June 16, or if it is a first-time claim, call Lynne Vergot, supervisor of the Board of Finance and Revenue at (717) 787-6534.

The forms also should be available through state legislator's district offices. Those offices should be listed in the local telephone directory.
