DUMP CAKE

1 stick butter
Melt in 13X9X2 pan in oven.
Dump 1 large can crushed pineapple with juice included on melted butter.

Put 1/4 package of yellow cake mix on top of pineapple.

Add 1 can of cherry pie filling.
Add remaining package of cake mix.

Cover this with 1 more stick of butter dotted over the top of cake mix.

Bake at 375 degrees for 45 minutes.

I like this recipe because it's very delicious and quick to make if you need something to serve at the last minute. It's great served hot right from the oven with vanilla ice cream and milk.

PUMPKIN CREAM CHEESE DESSERT

12 graham crackers
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 cup butter
Press into bottom of a cake pan.
Then mix:
2 eggs
1/4 cup sugar
8-ounce package cream cheese
Pour onto cracker crumbs and bake for 20 minutes.

Melt 1 pack unflavored gelatin in 1/4 cup cold water.

Cook 3 egg yolks
1/2 cup sugar
1/2 cup milk
2 cups pumpkin puree
Cook and add gelatin. Cool.
Then beat 3 egg whites and add to cooled pumpkin mixture. Top with whipped cream.

HAWAIIAN DESSERT

1 package (18 1/4 ounces) yellow cake mix
3 packages (3.4 ounces each) instant vanilla pudding mix
4 cups cold milk
1 1/2 teaspoons coconut extract
8-ounces cream cheese, softened
20-ounces crushed pineapple, well drained
2 cups heavy cream, whipped and sweetened

2 cups flaked coconut, toasted
Mix cake batter according to package directions. Pour into two greased 13x9x2-inch baking pans. Bake at 350 degrees for 15 minutes or until cake tests done. Cool completely. In a large mixing bowl, combine pudding mixes, milk and coconut extract; beat for 2

minutes. Add the cream cheese and beat well. Stir in pineapple. Spread over cooled cakes. Top with whipped cream; sprinkle with coconut. Chill for at least two hours.

Note: Prepared dessert can be covered and frozen for up to one month. Yield: 24 servings.
