

Atlantic National Awards Winners

ST. JOSEPH, Mo. — Judge Galen Fink, Manhattan, Kan., judged the 234 head of Angus cattle at the 1995 Atlantic National Roll of Victory (ROV) Angus Show held Memorial Day weekend in Timonium, Md.

In heifer competition, grand champion honors were presented to Ted Bourne Jr., Donalds, S.C., for his early spring heifer calf named Waldeck EF Forever Lady 9407. The January 1994 is a daughter of Waldeck Sky Traveler.

The reserve grand champion female was Harmony Hill Peg 417 owned by Longaberger Farms, Dresden, Ohio. The January 1994 daughter of N Bar Emulation EXT first won the reserve early spring calf division.

Whitestone Traveler 2149 topped the bull show by winning grand champion honors after being named senior champion. The September 1992 bull is sired by S S Traveler 6T6 and is owned by Whitestone Farm and Traveler 2149 Associates, both of Aldie, Va., and Pete Lettunich and Sons of Payette, Idaho.

The reserve grand champion bull was Brost Highlander 392 exhibited by Davis On The Highlands, Springfield, Ky. The entry first won the intermediate division and is a May 1993 son of G D A R Executive 727.
