Department Awards Grant To Statewide Group

has been awarded a \$2,500 direct
grant through the department's
Agriculture and Rural Youth Organization Grant Program.

The grant will be used to provide partial scholarships for the Council's Summer Youth Institute scheduled for June 25-28 at Shippensburg University.


Based in Altoona, the institute is a statewide program that selects and trains approximately 100 out-

standing rural youth annually, helping them develop an awareness of the cooperative way of doing business.

Young people attending the institute will focus on current issues in agriculture, learning how individuals and communities can work together to solve problems. There is also an opportunity for young people to meet with cooperative leaders and learn about career opportunities.

Under the Agriculture and Rural Youth Organization Grant Program, youth organizations such as 4-H and FFA apply for direct grants of up to \$2,500 and matching grants of up to \$15,000.

Direct grants may be used to fund educational projects, programs and seminars, and matching grants may be used to fund capital projects and equipment purchases.
