FREEDOM DAYS

Juneteenth, a verbal shorthand for the 19th of June, commemorates the date in 1865 when General Gordon Granger arrived in Texas with his troops to enforce Abraham Lincoln's Emancipation Proclamation abolishing slavery. In Texas, Juneteenth is a state holiday. Because the abolition of slavery in the United States was such a gradual process, however, it is celebrated in many ways and on several distinct occasions. Juneteenth is just one of these "freedom days," as is the first of January, commemorating the date of the actual proclamation, on New Year's Day in 1863. Let freedom ring

UNDERWATER RHUBARB

- 4 cups chopped rhubarb
- 1-1/2 cups sugar, divided
- 3 tablespoons butter
- 1 cup flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- pinch of salt
- 1/2 cup milk
- 1 tablespoon cornstarch
- 1 cup boiling water



Line an 8x8-inch pan with rhubarb. Cream together 3/4 cup sugar and the butter. Add flour, baking powder, and salt, and mix. Add the milk and mix again, then spread this batter over the rhubarb. Combine the remaining 3/4 cup sugar with the cornstarch and sprinkle over the batter, then pour the boiling water over all. Bake at 350° F for 1 hour.

Makes 6 servings.

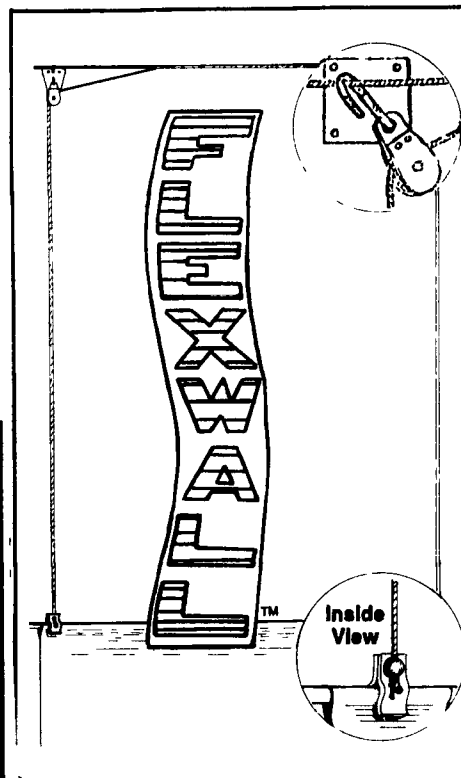
