
UNDERWATER RHUBARB

ine an 8x8-inch pan with rhubarb. Cream Ltogether 3/4 cup sugar and the butter. Add flour, baking powder, and salt, and mix Add the milk and mix again, then spread this batter over the rhubarb. Combine the remaining 3/4 cup sugar with the cornstarch and sprinkle over the batter, then pour the boiling water over all Bake at 350° F for 1 hour.




