Ag Department Awards Grants

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) - Agriculture Secretary Charles C. Brosius announced the Manheim FFA has been awarded a \$15,000 matching grant and a \$2,500 direct grant through the department's Agriculture and Rural Youth Organization Grant Program.

The matching grant will be used to construct an environmental laboratory for the FFA's use at Manheim Central High School. The direct grant will be used to purchase a video microscopy system for use in the agricultural curriculum at the school.

The Ecological Systems Laboratory (ESL) will contain laboratory facilities for the study of aquaculture, hydroponics, and horticulture. The lab will also be available for use by the Science and Home Economics departments.

Agricultural study is a graduation requirement in the Manheim School District. Many of the students using the lab will also be considering careers in agriculture.

The department's grant will be matched by area merchants and agribusinesses, Manheim Young Farmers Supporters and the Manheim FFA. The Manheim FFA's agricultural advisory committee is donating labor and technical support.

The video microscopy system uses a video camera placed over a microscope to project an image on a color monitor. The system will be used to display microscope slides, illustrate specimens, demonstrate instruments, display diagrams and show dissections.

Students will be encouraged to work cooperatively with others using the system to solve problems and explore agricultural science.

Under the Agriculture and Rural Youth Organization Grant Program, youth organizations such as 4-H and FFA apply for direct grants of up to \$2,500 and matching grants of up to \$15,000.

Direct grants may be used to fund educational projects, programs and seminars and matching grants may be used to fund capital projects and equipment purchases.
