With a good brain under a head full of bright red hair, the 1995 Bedford County Dairy Princess, Jennifer Brumbaugh of Saxton, RD 1, plans to be a veterinarian. She's gotten a good start by helping her dad treat the nearly 80

head of cattle on their picture pretty 250-acre farm.

Crowned at a pageant held on June 10, at the Northern Bedford County High School, Jennifer is the daughter of Roger and Kathleen Brumbaugh. She is a senior at Tussey Mountain High School. She also owns her own small herd

of dairy cattle.

Seven of the Brumbaugh cows belong to Jennifer. "My first was a Brown Swiss," Jennifer says. "She was a birthday present from my dad. She was also my show cow and I took a number of Reserve Junior Championships with her." Jennifer now has four Brown Swiss, two red and whites, and one Holstein which she milks herself. She and her brother, Sam, 12, also help with other work on the farm including unloading hay.

Always busy, Jennifer is involved in Russian Club, SADD, the National Honor Society, and Odyssey of the Mind at school.

At the Stonerstown Church of the Brethren, she is active in the church youth group and does some substitute Sunday School teaching.

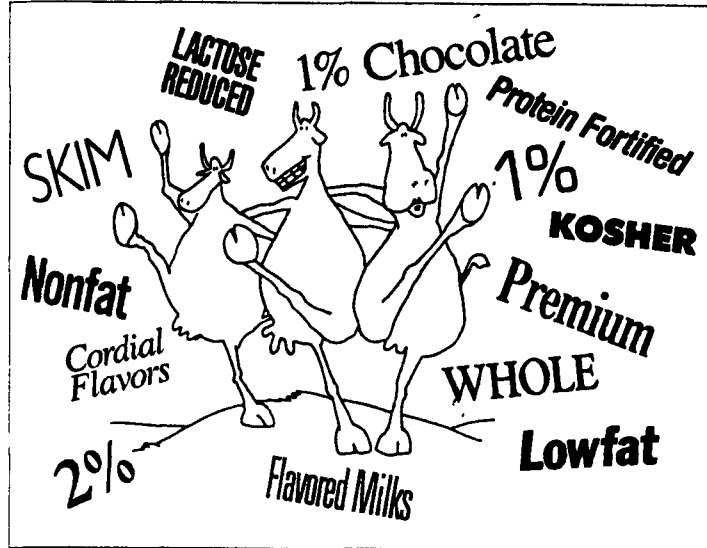

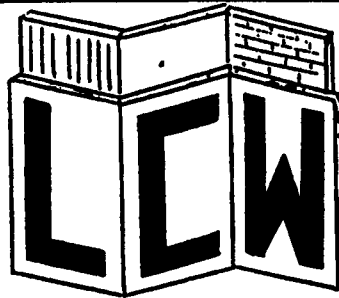

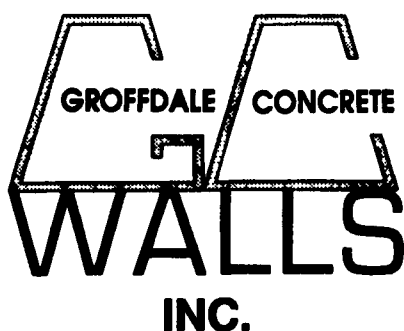
