


Lyons Farm

The Lyons Brothers, Bill and Bob, farm 350 acres, located west of Loysville. They have 70 registered Holsteins that produce a herd average of 20,094 pounds of milk. Milked in a tiestall barn the cows are fed a TMR ration that includes haylage and corn silage. The farm has been in the family for quite a few generations and it's this working together as a family that helps make the farming operation successful. Bill and his wife Crista have three children, Jenny, 15; Ben, 13, and David, 9.








Knowltstead Farm

At Knowitstead Farm, owned by Jack Knowiton, and with help from his daughter Rhoda, they farm 230 acres of corn and alfalfa to feed the dairy cows. The farm, that has been the family since the early 1950s, is located east of Coudersport in Potter County. They have 55 registered Holsteins that average 20,000 pounds of milk. Four or five of these cow are milking over 100 pounds per day. They also have 45 replacement heifers and calves. The cows are housed in a stantion barn, and they have a pipeline milker. Hard work over the years has helped to build a picturesque farm.
