



Davis Farm

Improvements to make the farm "look a lot nicer now than years ago" have been the hallmark for the Davis Farm Dairy of Distinction, according to George H. Davis, Sr. The Davis family farms in Meshoppen, Susquehanna County. Altogether, the operation encompasses 160 acres, of which most is used for crops, including 35 acres of corn, 30 acres of hay, and several acres in woods and pasture. George said that they raise a mix of 30 Holsteins and five Jerseys. They milk from tiestall to pipeline. Feed consistss of straight hay and corn, and field grass during the summer. The Davis's have owned the farm since 1965.





Henderson Family Farm

A lot of work involving cleaning up the grounds and converting marginally productive fields to hay fields have gone a long way to make the Henderson Family Farm a profitable and vigorous Dairy of Distinction. Said Dorothy Henderson, "I was born and raised on a farm and I married a fellow that liked farming, too." With husband Clyde and daughters Margie, 32, and Millie (married to Barry Fitzgerald), the Hendersons farm about 200 acres altogether in Lake Ariel, Wayne County. They care for about 49 grade Holsteins, milking tiestall to pipeline. They use some pasture ground and feed a mixed ration of 18 percent protein, including minerals and vitamins. The farm has been in the family about 38 years. Clyde and Dorothy have two grandchildren, Coleen, 11 and Brian, 9.




