






Ban-Queen-Sons


Bagging haylage, or "baylage," is the key to success for the 450-acre farm operation called Ban-Queen-Sons in Thompson, Wayne County. By getting the hay dried and into bales early, the protein is 4-5 percent higher than conventional methods, according to David Banicky. The Banicky family cares for registered Holsteins, including 55 milking and 50 young stock. Latest DHIA averages are 23,159 pounds milk, 879f, and 762p. Milking is from tiestall to pipeline. Feed is baylage and there are 70 acres devoted to intensive grazing. David farms with brother Joe and his family.






Kuzma's Dairy Farm

Consistency is the backbone of this profitable Dairy of Distinction, according to Ray Kuzma of Kuzma's Dairy Farm. Along with his mother, Delores, and wife Annette, Ray grows about 175 acres of crops (75 of corn and 100 of hay) on his Tunkhannock property in Wyoming County. The Kuzmas milk 59 registered and grade Holsteins, with about 50 young stock. On DHIA, they have a rolling herd average of 22,200 pounds. They milk from a tiestall to pipeline. The farm, in the family for 74 years, has been under their management for 15 years. Ray and Annette have one daughter, Katie, 6 mos.








