Chesapeake Clean Water Farmers To Sail The Bay

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) - Pennsylvania farmers from York, Franklin, and Bradford counties are to sail the Chesapeake Bay aboard the Chesapeake Bay Foundation's (CBF) vintage skipjack, the "Stanley Norman" on Monday, July 31.

Skipjacks are commercial sailing vessels historically unique to the Chesapeake Bay, and the "Stanley Norman," owned by the Foundation, is one of the few such workboats that remain in operation.

The farmers are winners of the Pennsylvania Chesapeake Bay Clean Water Farm Award sponsored jointly by Pennsylvania's Department of Agriculture and Environmental Protection. As part of the award recognition, the farmers and their families will participate in a CBF field trip on board the "Stanley Norman."

Leaving the Annapolis, Md. harbor at 9a.m., participants are to spend the day learning about the delicate ecosystem of the Chesapeake. The Bay trip will also include opportunities to see some of the methods used in commercial net fishing and oyster dredging ---the way it was done by Bay watermen a hundred years ago!

The award recipients and their families participating in the field trip are: Charles and Neva Allen, operators of a 1,000-acre dairy farm in Granville Summit, Bradford County; Jim, Sandra, and Kristina Bailey, operators of a 200-acre layer and hog farm in Spring Grove, York County; and Kenneth and Martha Myers. operators of a 278-acre dairy farm in St. Thomas, Franklin County.

CBF introduces people to the Bay through programs offered at 17 educational sites - from Pennsylvania to Norfolk, Virginia and from the Blue Ridge to the seaside. Annually, 35,000 students, teachers, and adults attend field trips offered by the Foundation.


