1/3 cup butter 1/3 cup lemon juice sait and pepper to taste 1-1/3 cups cooked rice 1 16-ounce package frozen chopped broccoli, thawed 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese

2 pounds fillet of sole

ix butter, lemon i juice, salt and pepper to make a sauce. Mix cooked rice, thawed broccoli, and shredded cheese with 1/3 of the sauce. Roll fillets around balls of the mixture, then pour remaining sauce over all.

Bake at 375° F in a 9x12-inch covered baking dish for 25 minutes.
