



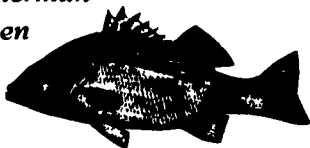

### THE ISINGLASS FISH

These primitive fish sport four barbels or feelers that hang down to help locate food, as well as an air float from which isinglass (for thickening jellies) is made. Sturgeons inhale crayfish, other small fish, snails, and larvae through their toothless mouths. Besides the common sturgeon of eastern North America, there are rock or lake sturgeon of the Great Lakes and Mississippi Valley, and the shovel-nosed sturgeon or hackleback, also of the Mississippi Valley.

### STUFFED FISH

- 1/3 cup butter
- 1/3 cup lemon juice
- salt and pepper to taste
- 1-1/3 cups cooked rice
- 1 16-ounce package frozen chopped broccoli, thawed
- 1 cup shredded Cheddar cheese
- 2 pounds fillet of sole

Mix butter, lemon juice, salt and pepper to make a sauce. Mix cooked rice, thawed broccoli, and shredded cheese with 1/3 of the sauce. Roll fillets around balls of the mixture, then pour remaining sauce over all. Bake at 375° F in a 9x12-inch covered baking dish for 25 minutes.

Makes 4 servings.

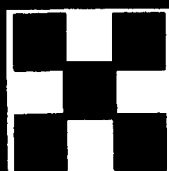
