# Lamb, Ewe Sale Set

**UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre Co.)**—The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture's Meat Animal Evaluation Center is making final arrangements for Pennsylvania's 17th Performance tested Ram Lamb and Invitational Ewe sale.

This sale is scheduled for Saturday, August 5, at the Ag Arena on the campus of The Pennsylvania State University.

The rams finished their 84-day testing period on July 11. Glenn Eberly, director of the center, reported this group of rams has shown outstanding performance.

The group being considered for sale consists of 14 spring-born Dorsets, 17 fall-born Dorsets, 18 Suffolk, one of which is a fall born ram. Two Hampshires, and one Oxford. The average daily gains

on test this year were very good. The spring-born Dorsets averaged .95 pounds per day through the 84-day testing period, with two lambs posting the top gain within this breed group of 1.11 pounds/day. These two rams were consigned by Ken Staver and Family and Dan Heilman, respectively. The fall-born Dorsets averaged .82 pounds per day.

The November-born ram consigned by Genetic Visions Stock Farm set the standard with a gain of .98 pounds per day. The 17 spring-born Suffolks gained very well, posting an average daily gain of 1.15 pounds per day.

David and Tracy Cole's February-born twin ram recorded the top average daily gain over all breeds, 1.40 pounds per day.

The second fastest gain over all breeds was recorded by a Suffolk. This January-triplet consigned by Yeo Farms of Lowellville, Ohio gained an impressive 1.35 pounds per day.

Hall Suffolks of Chestertown, Md. consigned the lone fall-born Suffolk. This 272-pound September-born triplet ram gained

1.21 pounds per day through the 84-day test. The two Hampshire rams consigned by Clyde Brubaker and Tom Nickeson gained .98 pounds per day and .82 pounds per day, respectively.

The very impressive Oxford ram consigned by Jeffrey Everett gained 1.21 pounds per day on test. The rams will be slick-shorn, scanned ultrasonically, and given a breeding soundness exam within the next few days. An index will be calculated to rank the rams within their breed groups.

A sale committee of sheep producers and members of the sheep technical committee will meet to evaluate the rams for soundness and breed character. Those not meeting minimum requirements, as well as the lower indexing rams, will be eliminated from the sale.

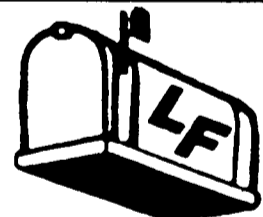
