Higher cost of gains and strong 4th quarter CME slaughter contracts creating excellent demand for heavy feeders that will have short turn in feedlots. The light supply of yearling feeders throout the country that are available to feedlots at present has also sparked demand. Quality of supply plain to average, end attractive. Feeder cattle flesh condition attractive and mostly medium to thin; calves varied from slightly thin thru soft with most in medium condition. Bulk of supply in average fill condition. Slaughter cows steady. Slaughter bulls 1.00 higher. Packer demand moderate to good. Several high quality, ranch fresh pairs included in supply. Demand for replacements good, especially for pairs.

Total of 491 cows and bulls sold with near 45 percent returning to the country.




