

Wivell's Thor Ada Tops Elizabethtown Open Show

ELIZABETHTOWN (Lancaster Co.) — A state record two year-old, showing fresh again, was named the grand champion for Joe Wivell, Columbia, at the Elizabethtown Fair Dairy Show Thursday. Kulp-Dale Thor Ada, VG 87, with an excellent udder, milked over 35,000m 1000f 1000p.

The reserve grand champion was shown by Denise Bollinger and listed under Darryl Bollinger, Manheim, in the catalogue. The Bollinger family entry was the first place four year-old. Denise also had the reserve grand champion in the youth show with her aged cow.

The junior champion of the Holstein breed was shown by Stacy Weidler, Lawn, and Heather Oberholtzer, Elizabethtown, had the reserve junior champion.

Amy Brandt, Elizabethtown, had the grand champion in the youth show with her two year-old and then was named supreme champion of the youth dairy show over all breeds.

In the Jersey show, the Dice brothers from Fredericksburg had the champions. Edward had the grand champion with his junior champion senior heifer calf, and Andrew had the reserve grand champion with his reserve junior champion intermediate heifer calf.

Jason Henisee, Donegal, had the only Guernsey entry, a senior heifer calf that was named both junior and grand champion for the breed.

Sandra McCauley, Elizabethtown, was the judge.

Association, Select Sires Make Agreement

BRATTLEBORO, Vt.—The board of directors of the Ayrshire Breeders Association has approved an agreement with Select Sires, Plain City, Ohio to conduct the type evaluations of Ayrshire cows.

"This is a bold step," said Jim McConnell, president.

"This will effectively reduce costs by more than 50 percent to the breeders and stimulate participating in the breed's type evaluation program used in genetic evaluations and marketing.

"The association is continuing to step up efforts to put such progressive action into place to provide breeders improved opportu-

ity for breeding more productive, longer living and thus more profitable herds of Ayrshires."

Animal registrations have increased in each of the past two years for the association. Export markets have increased as has the domestic interest due to the recognition of the superior grazing capabilities of the breed.

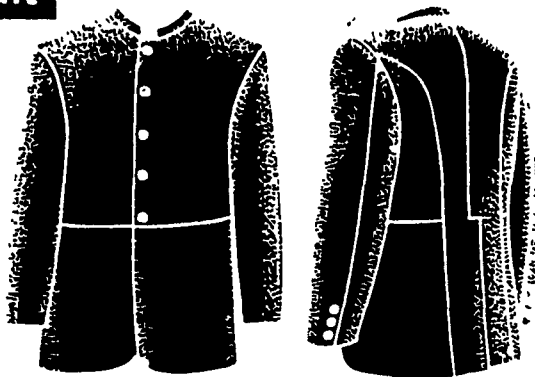
