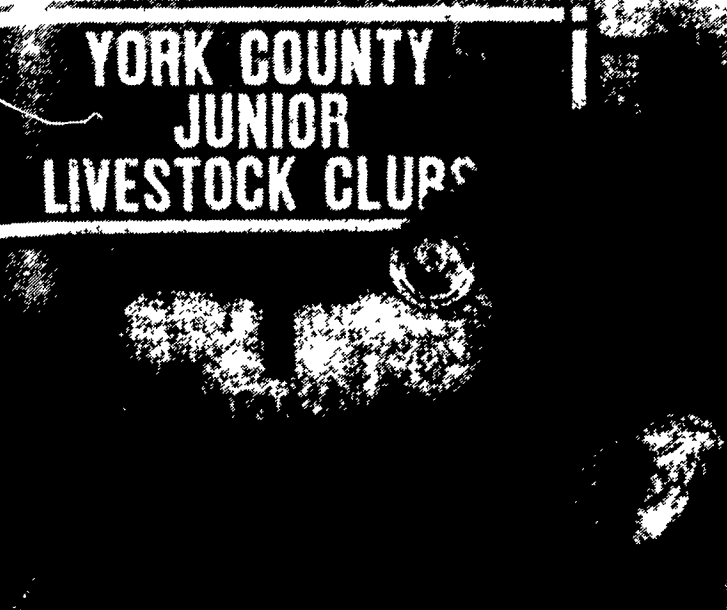

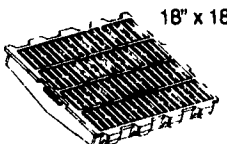


Plastic Flooring

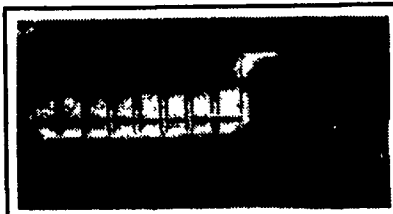
