'Energy Dense' Hybrids

SHIREMANSTOWN (Cumberland Co.)—The Beachley-Hardy Seed Company announces the release of three new "Energy Dense" Hytest® brand seed corn hybrids for 1996 planting in mid-Atlantic dairy and livestock farms.

"Energy Dense" or "ED" technology increases oil content over normal hybrid corns by 50 percent or more. Since oil is 225 percent more energy-dense than starch (which makes up the endosperm of normal dent corn), ED corn transfers this benefit to the ration, giving the livestock producer a greater feed response on a pound for pound basis.

In addition, higher amounts of these key amino acids results in high quality protein for all types of livestock. Conservative estimates are that lysine is improved 16 per-

cent, methionine 6 percent, and tryptophan 15 percent as compared to normal dent corn hybrids.

Producers using ED corn products for dairy silage and in poultry or swine rations indicate that ED corn is preferred by livestock when given the choice with a conventionally balanced ration.

The three hybrids being released are Hytest® Brand BH4495ED, Hytest® Brand BH4605ED, and Hytest® Brand BH4714ED. BH4495ED is a 95-day relative maturity hybrid which has a wide area of adaptation. BH4605ED is a 105-day relative maturity hybrid which has exceptional high-end yield potential. BH4714ED is a 114-day relative maturity hybrid with excellent drought tolerance.

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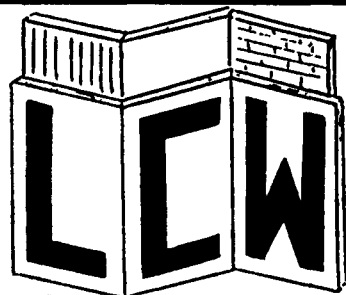
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
