broiler, turkey, and egg producers. Topics range from avian influenza to food safety programs to consumer perceptions and expectations.

Poultry producers and agriindustry representatives are invited to attend the three-day show.

The poultry show is preceded by a golf tournament on Tuesday, Sept. 26, which begins at noon with an outdoor barbecue. The show closes on Thursday at 5:30 p.m. (\$40 per ticket) with the famous "Harvest Reception," featuring four different serving areas

with an elaborate selection of poultry, beef and lamb, fish, and fruit and cheese.

A popular attraction for the show is the exhibit hall, open free of charge on Wednesday and Thursday afternoons from noon until 5 p.m. More than 100 exhibitors will display the newest pro-

ducts and services in the industry.






