KUTZTOWN (Berks Co.) — A 5-Year-Old Alpine by the name of Vicki Lynn was selected grand champion of the Reading Fair Goat Show on Monday at the Kutztown Fairgrounds.

Exhibitor for the champion was Joan Stump, Stump Hollow Farm, Telford.

Stump said the animal was obtained from Martha Griner, Bordentown, N.J. Stump said genetics are essential when exhibiting a goat for championship, and to enhance the overall quality of the breed.

Stump will be showing this year at the state Farm Show.

In all, there were a total of 10 exhibitors and 76 goats. Show judge was John Pfeiler, Shortsville, N.Y., a Nubian and Alpine goat breeder.

Management Workshop For Youth Set

UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre Co.) — For several years, faculty in the Department of Dairy and Animal Science at Penn State have conducted very successful management workshops for high school students interested in the dairy industry.

In 1994, this program was expanded to include workshops for students interested in beef cattle and swine.

Dairy cattle, sheep and horses will be featured in the 1995 Animal Management Workshop for Youth. The goal of the workshop is to provide interested college-bound high school sophomores, juniors and seniors with the opportunity to study in more depth the current issues facing producers of animals and animal products.

Topics to be addressed in the combined morning session include

comparative reproductive anatomy and hoof structure and health. The afternoon sessions will focus on topics specific to each of the three species, including nutritional trials and body condition scoring.

The 1995 Animal Management Workshop for Youth is scheduled for Friday, Oct. 13 from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

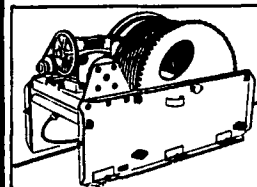

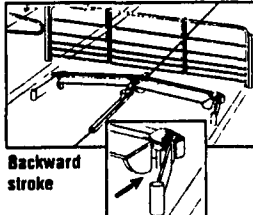
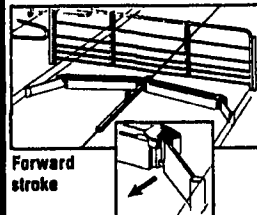
