

# Junior Swine Winners Named At York

**YORK (York Co.)** — Tammi Grubb, Hanover, took grand champion honors in the York Fair's Junior Market Swine competition with her 228-pound winner of the medium weight division.

In the reserve grand champion spot was the 236-pound entry of Jason Frantz, Seven Valleys, which had taken the reserve spot as well in the medium weight classes.

The pair bested division champions from three other weight classes in the final runoffs for the show's overall best pigs. Taking lightweight top honors were Adam Sellers, champion, and Jeremy Wilson, reserve. Sharing the light heavyweight awards were Lauri

Bish, champion, and Mike Sollers, reserve. Heavyweight champion winner was Adam Sellers, over reserve winner Alisha Eberly.

In the breeding swine classes, Lane Innerst, Red Lion, took all the honors. Top awards in the Duroc breed classes were shared by Heather Jasenski, Felton, who exhibited the champion sow, and reserve exhibitor Kathleen Jenkins, Fawn Grove.

Matt Trostle, Red Lion, took champion ribbon honors in the Hampshire classes, while the reserve rosette went to Jeremy Wilson, New Freedom. Kathleen Jenkins lone entry in the Spotted Poland class earned her another set of champion rosettes.

Yorkshire competition wrapped

up with champion honors won by Jon Neutzal, Felton. Taking the reserve champion spot was Russell Wilson, New Freedom.

In the senior age exhibitor competition, Matt Trostle, Red Lion, was champion showman and Kelly Myers, Thomasville, champion fitter. Bobbi Myers, Thomasville, won the intermediate age showmanship, with fitting honors going to Michael Burrell, Dover. Lane Innerst, Red Lion, topped the junior division showmanship, while Beth Parrish, York, won fitting honors. Beginner showman honors went to Rick Jones, East Berlin, while Jennifer Huntington, Jacobus, was the fitting winner.
