Pa. Beef Expo At Penn State

STATE COLLEGE (Centre Co.)—Pennsylvania's 7th annual PA Beef Expo is scheduled for Thursday, March 28 through Sunday March 31 at the Ag Arena on the campus of Penn State University.

It was determined to combine the Beef Expo, the 23rd annual performance tested Bull Sale, and the Pennsylvania Cattlemen's Association's (PCA's) annual education program and annual banquet. The hope is to have one grand beef weekend.

The general schedule this year calls for the educational program to be conducted Thursday March 28, the bull sale will be Friday at noon, to be followed by a brand new addition this year, the first annual Commercial Heifer Sale. The Pennsylvania Cattlemen's Association annual banquet is slated for Friday evening. The purebred sales will be conducted Saturday, March 30 along with the beef judging contest and the Beef Skillathon. Sunday, March 31 will feature the junior steer and heifer shows.

There had been a great deal of interest expressed in the inaugural Commercial Heifer Sale. The Beef Expo wishes to expand its mission and provide more of a ser-

vice to the commercial industry. This endeavor should provide an outlet for quality open and bred heifers as well as a reliable source of commercial heifers, 10 to 22 months of age for anyone looking to acquire healthy, desirable breeding stock.
