# **Deer Permits**

crop farms, deer may not be killed from May 16 to July 31.

For vegetable farms, the permit hunting is closed from May 16 to June 30.

These no-hunting periods have been established to allow deer to fawn and raise their young while crop damage is generally limited (because of the crop's growth stage and behavior of deer).

Those allowed to hunt with a permit must be at least 18 years old, be a bona fide resident of the state and possess a valid hunting license.

Further, hunters using a permit must wear at least 250 square inches of daylight flourescent organge-colored material on the head, chest, and back combined, so it is visible on the hunter from 360 degrees.

Each successful subpermit hunter is to tag the deer and report the kill to the farmer/permitee.

While the program has been

approved, the application forms, the permit forms and the reporting forms are yet to be developed by the Game Commission.

According to Dave Overcash, with the Commission's Bureau of Law Enforcement, tho e already enrolled in the Hot Spo. program will be notified by letter of the effective dates, details, and availability of forms.

Those wishing to become involved who are not currently enrolled in the Hot Spot program should inquire through their regional Game Commission headquarters office.


