"There are many

areas where Grange policy must be inserted and sustained," Hiller said. "Grange influence and integrity remain high, and we must continue to expand our list of legislative accomplishments while maintaining our vigilance in Harrisburg and Washington."

. Hiller said the accomplishments of the past with a vision toward the future will guide the organization as the Grange continues to tackle issues facing communities and the agricultural industry.

"The Grange must continue to be a leading force, in partnership with organizations of similar views, and recognize that agriculture is now, more than ever before, a business - big business - and more than a way of life, for that way of life means simply to exist. We must do more than that."

As a grass-roots organization, policies are formulated at the local and county level and then passed to the state Grange in the form of a resolution.

Once passed, the resolution becomes Grange policy and those policies, which have federal implications, are submitted for consideration at the National Grange convention in November.




