The Shrewsbury Fire Hall is located in Shrewsbury, on Route 851, west of Exit 1 of Interstate 83.

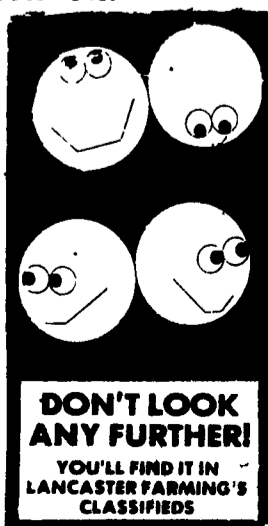
Chester To Hold Annual Meeting
