is less than 5 percent of the minimum requirement for the bitch, the housing shall be approved by the attending veterinarian."

This last part is an example of some of clarification of what is the expected responsibility and competency of attending veterinarians.

The watering requirements for dogs being transported have been made more specific and demand more attention by the caretaker.

Under the old set of rules, water was only required once every 12 hours, while dogs were being transported.

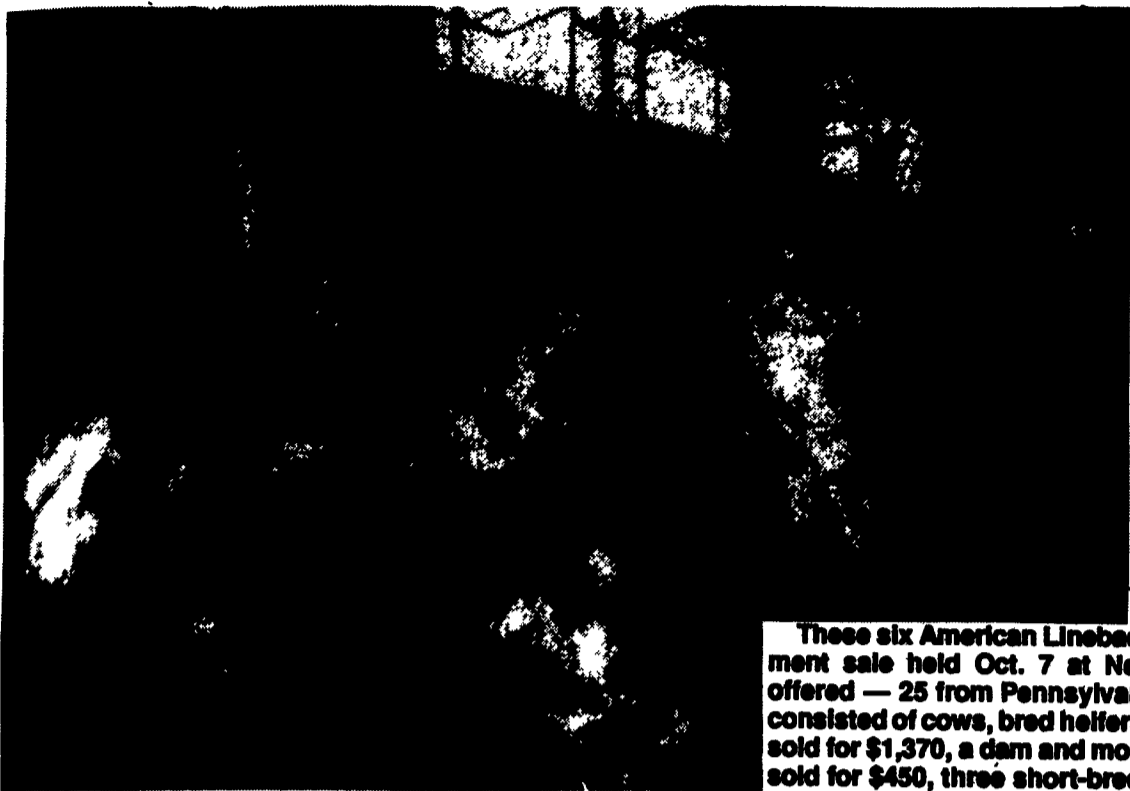
Under the new regulations,

mature dogs (those over 6 months old) must be offered fresh water for at least a 10-minute interval every six hours.

For dogs under 6 months, the requirement is to be fresh water being offered for at least 10 minutes every four hours.

The department may also now test or require testing of water offered to dogs, and may make inspections of facilities at any time.

These six American Lineback cows averaged \$1,245 after being sold at a consignment sale held Oct. 7 at New Holland Sales Stables. A total of 37 head were offered — 25 from Pennsylvania, five from Wisconsin, seven from Maryland — and consisted of cows, bred heifers, and bull and female calves. Out of the cows sold, one sold for \$1,370, a dam and month-old heifer calf sold for \$1,700, a 4-month-old heifer sold for \$450, three short-bred heifers sold for \$975 each, and the top bull calf, 5 1/2 months old, sold for \$425. The Lineback registry reports that 13 of the 17 buyers are new Lineback owners.

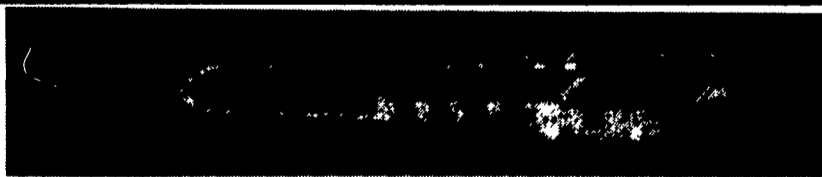
