Compared to last Monday: Feeder cattle and calves steady to 2.00 higher. Feeder steer demand good; yearling heifers continue to be scarce. Calf demand remains moderate but somewhat improved from past several weeks. Yearling quality average to many plain with thin to medium flesh and average to full weigh-ups. Calf quality near average. Calf flesh condition generally medium to fleshy but some increase is noted in thinner type long term weaned calves. With rain forecasted for this week buyers are reporting more farmer interest in calves. Slaughter cows 2.50-3.50 lower with Cutters at the full decline. Slaughter bulls 1.00 lower. Packer demand fairly good despite large numbers available. This week is the typical start of Oklahoma's fall cow run. Cow numbers this week are 27 percent larger than the same week last year at this sale. October cow numbers were 8 percent larger than October 1994. Majority of cows are old and in typical culling condition. 1,140 cows and bulls sold. Receipts this week 12,400; last week 11,475; last year 16,069. Supply consisted of 50 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 41 percent calves under 600 lbs; 9 percent cows and bulls.
