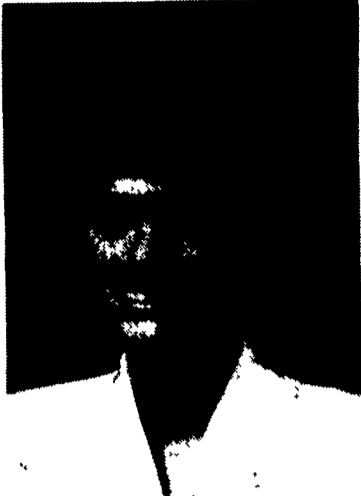


# Atlantic Dairy Cooperative Announces Management Changes

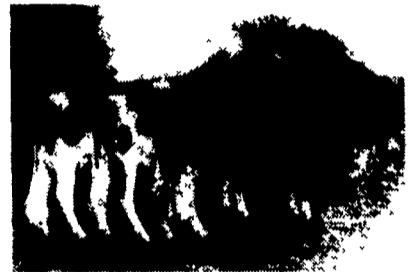

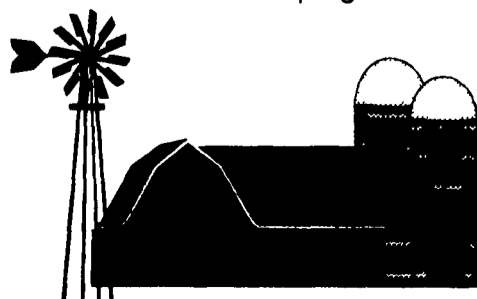

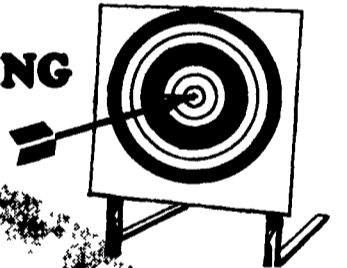
