and retail developments, he said. Lines said farmers still need to be cautious, but not necessarily afraid of re-entering the land market. Buying land makes sense if it makes the operation more efficient than other investments. The farmer should also consider whether a bigger operation will improve the family's standard of

living, he said. However, a farmer can get the same benefits by renting land, which can be cheaper than an outright purchase. Farmers who rent also forgo capital gains increases.

To play it safe, the farmer should be able to cover a "significant portion" of the land purchase in cash. He recommends an amount equal to half of the purchase price.

Farmers' main concern should be to learn from history and not repeat mistakes of overeagemess, Lines said.

"I want farmers to be wary of what happened 15 years ago," he said. "Don't bypass the memory or experience some other people had by making what seemed to be a good deal and having it go sour."
