The Dairymen's Club honored Penn State professor Stephen B. Spencer as the recipient of its 1995 Service Award. He is recognized internationally as an expert on milking machines and systems, and his work has earned him 11 awards, including this year's Alfa Laval Agri Dairy Extension Award presented by the American Dairy Science Association.

After earning bachelor's and master's degrees at Penn State, Spencer began his extension career as a county agent in 1957. He has served on 27 committees at Penn State as well as the boards of the National Mastitis Council, the American Dairy Science Association, and the International Association of Milk, Food and Environment Sanitarians. He has written

many articles for publications, including Hoard's Dairyman.

Also at the banquet Peter Witter, who works for the PA Department of Agriculture, made a slide presentation on how the state assists small to medium-sized agribusinesses with selling their food products in the world market. Senior dairy science students were introduced to club members.
