An 1856 vintage Savage revolver — which sold for \$575 — was the oldest weapon on the block at a Saturday consignment sale of 138 new and antique guns at Horst Auction Center, 50 Durlach Road, Ephrata. Six collectors offered guns at the auction.

Among the antique firearms were an 1862 U.S. Bridesburg long rifle with bayonet \$2300, two 1860s vintage Colt revolvers \$450 and \$800, 1866 Remington pistol \$450, and 1884 U.S. Springfield rifle \$400. Of a half-dozen swords offered at auction, the oldest, a 19th-century antique, brought \$290.
