CRANBERRY-APPLE SLAW

12-ounce bag whole cranberries 1/4 cup orange juice concentrate juice of 1 lemon 6 large apples, McIntosh or Cortland

n a food processor, blender, or meat grinder, coarsely chop or grind the cranberries, adding 515 the orange juice concentrate and the lemon juice

until just blended. This part of the recipe can be made ahead and refrigerated until needed. Just before serving, core and shred the apples in a food processor or with a hand grater. Combine the shredded apple with the cranberry-orange mixture and toss until mixed. Chopped nuts

or raisins can be

added as desired.

Serve immediately.

Makes 6 servings.
