Lancaster County — The Next Los Angeles?

The Lancaster Chamber of Commerce and Industry agriculture committee along with the Lancaster Farm and Home Foundation will hold a "Town Meeting" on Thursday, December 7, from 7 to 9 p.m., at the Farm and Home Center. The focus of the program is "Lancaster County—The Next Los Angeles?"

Preserving the viability and sustainability of agriculture is a top priority of many organizations in Lancaster County, but at the same time there exists an accelerating change of properties to non-agriculture land uses. This is a trend similar to growth patterns in such areas as Orange County, CA, and Cook County, IL—which now boast very little agriculture.

The meeting format will include 10-15 minute presentations from representatives of the business community, farming community, planning commission, and the tourist industry. This will be followed by a panel discussion on public policy and keeping agriculture strong in Lancaster County.

Presenters include Ron Bailey, Lancaster County Planning Commission; Harry Flick, Pennsylvania Dutch Convention and Visitors Bureau; Darwin Boyd, CoreStates Hamilton Bank; and Dale Hershey, dairy farmer. Panelists include Nelson Rohrer, Manheim Township Board of Commissioners; Terry Kauffman, Lancaster County Commissioner; John Barley, Pennsylvania House of Representatives, 100th legislative district; and Noah Wenger, Pennsylvania Senate, 36th legislative district.

Following the panel discussion will be an open forum for questions and discussion, moderated by Jim Shirk, the Chamber's agriculture services manager.
