The regulations that have been developed are farmer-friendly and should not be a burden on a dairy operation. The end result will be a better environment, cleaner water, and a wiser and more profitable use of manure on the farm.

The day-long program will conclude with a panel that is to include two farmers and one vet-

erinarian, with Dr. O'Connor as the moderator, discussing reproduction management down on the farm.

Questions on heat detection, record keeping, treatment of problem breeders, are just a few of the topics that will be covered. There will be ample time for questions.

tive note and come to Chester County Dairy Day at the Oxford Fire Hall.

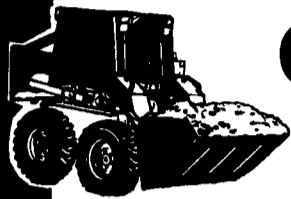

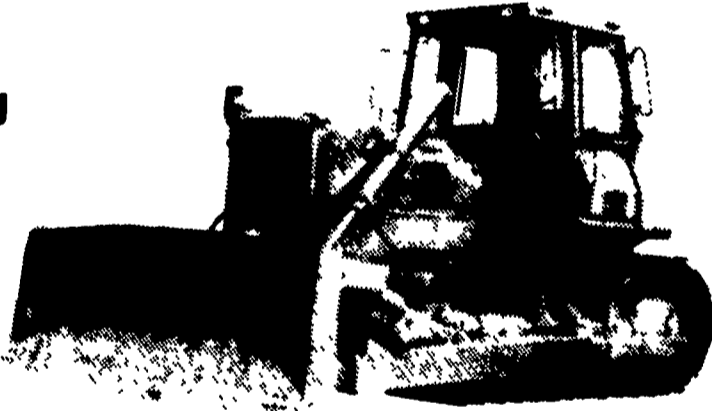
