ST. JOSEPH, MO
NOVEMBER 29, 1995
Grain and soybean bids jumped sharply higher. Wheat rebounded on favorable outlook for export demand and reports of dry conditions in winter wheat growing areas. Corn bids turned higher on fund buying and strong wheat trade. Soybean bids were supported by improved export interest and carryover strength from wheat pits. Wheat 1 to 8 cents higher. Corn 1 to 5 cents higher. Sorghum 9 to 13 cents higher. Soybeans 6 to 9 cents higher. Wheat bids climbed out of a two day rut with support stemming from indications Morocco, Egypt, and Sri Lanka may soon seek US wheat. Winter wheat areas of the Plains States are experiencing very dry conditions which also pushed wheat bids upward. Fund buying on the board gave corn bids new life along with ideas export demand may soon pick up. Farmer selling remains light. Overnight export sale from Taiwan and strength from corn and wheat bids, boosted bean bids.
