every farm transaction in Lancaster County involving an Amish party represented a gain or retention for the Amish. The Amish lost no farms during these two years.

· Of Amish to Amish transactions, 47% were family sales. Of Mennonite to Mennonite transactions, only 12% were family sales.

• Of all farm sales in Lancaster County since 1984, 8% were family sales among the Amish.

• The Amish are buying larger farms (average of 76 acres) and selling smaller farms (average of 70 acres). Progressive Plain Groups and the English are buying farms smaller than those they are selling.

 Corporations are paying the highest price for farmland at \$11,379 per acre. The average for Traditional Plain Groups is \$5,288, for Progressive Plain Groups \$5,477, and for Unidentified \$6,498.

friends and relatives. Set a price limit for gifts and have everyone agree in advance.


