Compared to last week: Feeder steers and steer calves steady to 1.00 higher. Feeder heifers and heifer calves steady. Demand good for a light supply of feeder cattle. Demand for calves good early, moderate late. Calf flesh becoming more attractive to buyers as large percentage in medium flesh. Weigh-ups mostly average. Slaughter cows 50-1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls steady. Demand good from packers, replacement, and feeder cow buyers. Near 650 cows and bulls sold with 60 percent going to packers. Supply consisted of 50 percent yearlings and numerous calves over 600 lbs; 42 percent calves under 600 lbs, 8 percent cows and bulls. Receipts this week 8,550; last week 9,947; last year 8,388. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
