

Va. Fair Honors Angus Champions

RICHMOND, Va. — Breeders paraded 55 heifers, 24 bulls, and three cow-calf pairs for judge Jack Ward, Roanoke, Ind., here at the 1995 Virginia State Fair Angus Show.

Top honors in the bull show went to Hill Crest Viper 033, an April 1993 son of V D A R New Trend 802. Annfield Corporation, Boyce, Va.; Susan Rucker, Delaplane, Va.; and Houston Moore Jr., Lewisburg, W. Va., own the winning entry that was first named senior champion.

Taking home the reserve grand champion bull title was Justin Updike, Washington, on his senior bull calf champion entry named Skyway Hills 6807 1126. He is a

Ward selected Ankony Pride V714 as his grand champion female. The February 1994 daughter of N Bar Emulation EXT was exhibited by Clear View Farm, Louisa. She first topped the junior division.

The reserve grand champion female was I N A Pride 810V, a September 1994 daughter of Rito 9FB3 of 5H11 Fullback. John Nicolai Jr., Gordonsville, owns the entry that first won the senior heifer calf division.

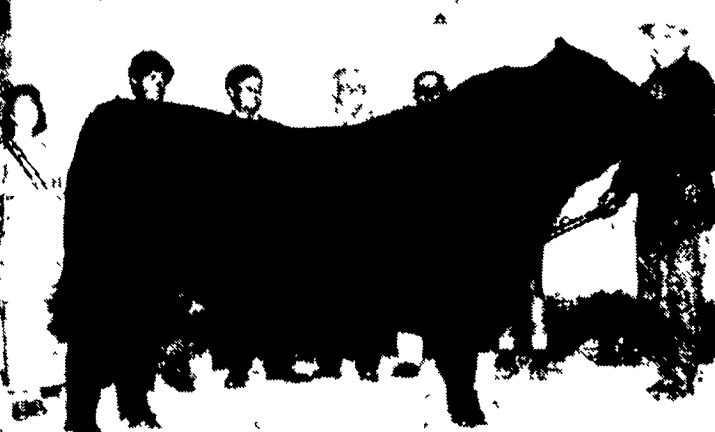
