OKLAHOMA CITY, OK
DECEMBER 13, 1995
Compared to Monday of last week: Feeder cattle, and calves steady to 1.00 lower. Demand moderate and uneven. Quality plain to average. Calves continue to decline in flesh with many in thin to medium condition. Weigh-ups average to full. Last weekends cold front provided practically no moisture for Oklahoma's wheat country. Another dry week is in progress. Slaughter cows 2.00-3.00 higher, bulls firm. Demand excellent from packers. Winter weather up north and expected shorter numbers within next three weeks prompted higher market. Total of 675 cows and bulls sold with 75 percent to packers. Receipts this week 11,200; last week 14,188; last year 7,875. Supply consisted of 61 percent yearlings and numerous calves over 600 lbs; 33 percent calves under 600 lbs; 6 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
