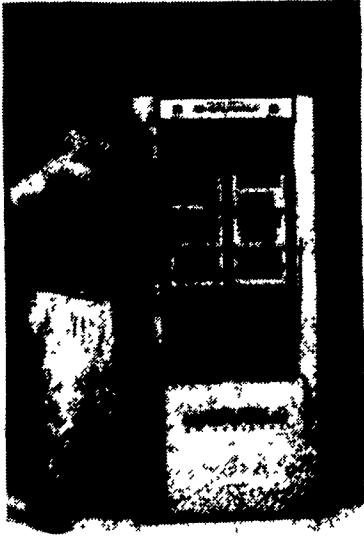

the radio's critical components; and vibration-free design.

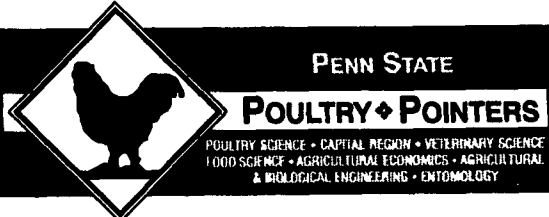
"The backup lighting and regu-

a market for ratite products — meat, leather and oils.

- In ostrich, research projects on carcass composition, ideal slaughter weights and slaughter conditions, and decreasing fat deposition are being conducted. Much of this research is being done at Texas A & M University.

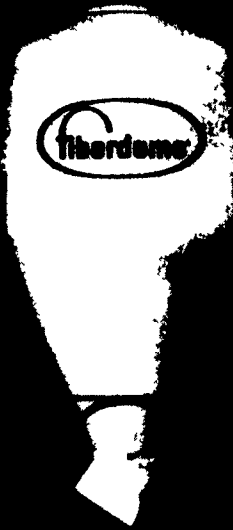
- A few disease research projects are being conducted as follows: pullorum/typhoid infection/

transmission in ratites (University of Georgia); diarrhea (Auburn University); aspergillosis, typically a problem in colder, wetter climates (no specific research site mentioned).

Hicks-Aldredge noted that slaughter ostrich prices are \$500-\$800 per bird. The ostriches are typically slaughtered at 9 months of age at approximately 220 pounds.
