

Jr. Holstein Awards Deadlines Near

STATE COLLEGE (Centre Co.) — Application deadlines are fast approaching for several awards and scholarships sponsored by the Pennsylvania Junior Holstein Association.

The Pa. Junior Holstein Association has many award applications due in January. There are also three, \$1,000 scholarships to be awarded during the February Junior Holstein Convention for which applications are still being accepted.

The award applications due by Jan. 1 are for the Junior Progressive Breeder Award, Total Performance Award, 30,000-pound Cow Award, and the Breeder of an Excellent Cow Award.

Applications due Jan. 11 are for the Youth Achievement Scholarship Award, Distinguished Junior Member Award, and the Dairy Bowl Contest.

Those interested in the scholarship application should also contact the Holstein Association.

The scholarship applicant can be attending or planning to attend a four-year school, two-year school, technical school, short course, breeding school, computer school or other post-secondary educational program.

Applicants may also use the scholarship for advertising and promotion of their herd, purchase of semen, embryos or cattle for herd improvement.

Those who apply must have



completed a Senior Division Distinguished Junior Member Book at some time.

The scholarships are to recognize Holstein Association youth for their achievements, leadership

and accomplishments in youth programs. The winners will be selected based on completion of the application and an interview with a panel of judges at the Junior Convention, scheduled to be held at the Genetti Hotel, in Williamsport.

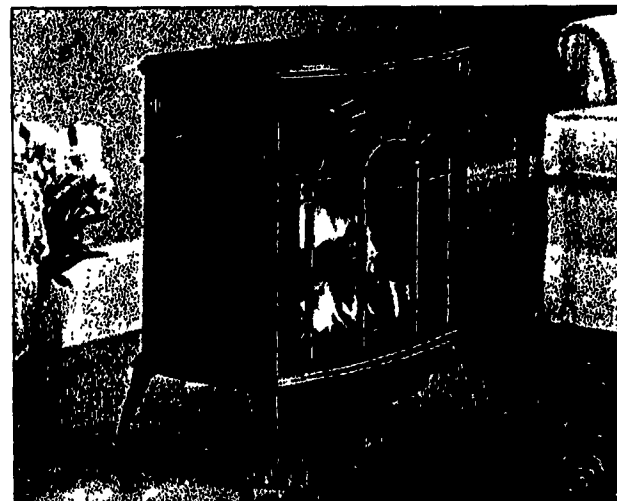

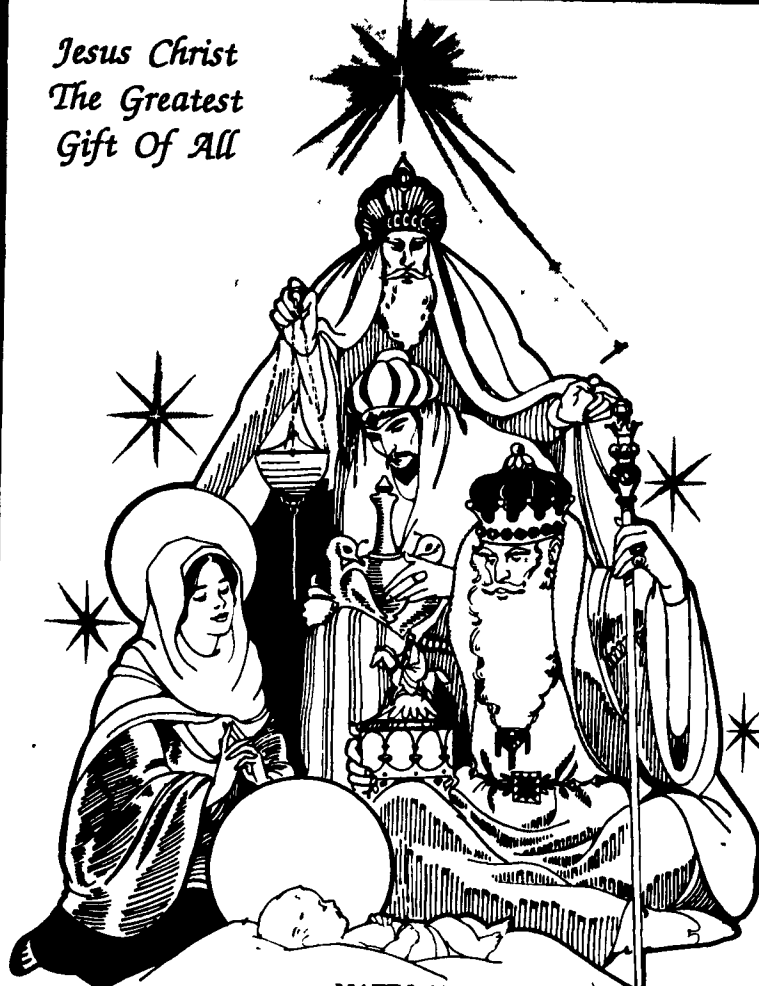
