DECEMBER 27, 1995

Prices were unchanged to lower in New England, Texas, and Louisiana; elsewhere, prices were unchanged. The market tone was steady at best with brown eggs still in the steadiest position. Demand was mixed from fair to good, best where post-holiday retail restocking occurred. Supplies were adequate or available for white eggs except occasionally cartoned eggs were tight, and brown eggs were no more than adequate. Breaking stock supplies were at least adequate, and demand remained light as most plants worked reduced schedules. Spent hen offerings were also at least adequate for the light and unaggressive demand, and plant schedules were also reduced.
