
# Limas Pack Big Nutrition

NEWARK, Del. - If you're looking for a nutritious food, check out lima beans. A 1/2 cup contains 85 to 95 calories. Fordhooks are at the light end, calorically speaking; the baby limas are just a tad heavier. Baby limas offer 5 milligrams of vitamin C, Fordhooks have 11 milligrams, or between 6 and 17 percent of the recommended daily allowance of vitamin C for adults. Lima beans also contain more than 10 percent of the RDA for iron and offer significant fiber. Overall, limas are a nutritious package when eaten as part of a balanced diet.


Although lima beans are a good food choice, Dr. Sue Snider, cooperative Extension food and nutrition specialist at the University of Delaware, says that they've



never become a favorite, or even a regularly eaten, vegetable in this country. Only one pound per person is consumed in the United

"Many people eat limas in combination with other vegetables," says Snider. "In fact, it is often served with corn as succotash."

1 pound frozen corn, thawed




Hilary Spiller used consumer response to her "Blue Hen" lima beans to determine product and packaging qualities that affect purchase decisions.



while traveling.'


