Compared to last week: Feeder cattle and calves over 600 lbs steady to 2.00 lower; lighter weight calves 1.00-2.00 higher. Demand moderate for feeders. Demand moderate for calves and improved from past several weeks. Quality of the supply average to many attractive and this the best genetic quality in some months. Bulk of calves weaned and medium to thin in flesh. Feeder cattle in mostly medium flesh. Weigh-ups average. Slaughter cows and bulls 1.50-2.00 lower. Demand from pack-

ers fair to moderate with only minimal action from northern buyers. Large supply of thin shelly cows in consist. 682 cows and bulls sold with 60 percent to packers. Receipts this week 12,600; last week 10,699; last year 16,893. Supply consisted of 67 percent yearlings and calves numerous calves over 600 lbs; 28 percent calves under 600 lbs; 5 percent cows and bulls.
