JANUARY 24, 1996
Compared to last Monday: Feeder cattle steady to 2.00 lower. Demand moderate for feeders. Steer calves steady with good demand. Heifer calves 1.00-2.00 lower

with light to moderate demand. Quality of supply plain to mostly average with modest end attractive; this well below the excellent genetic quality of last week. Feeder cattle flesh condition highly varied from fairly fleshy to slightly thin. Cattle off wheat are very limited compared to past two years and often times extra flesh due more to feed than grazing. Calf flesh medium to thin. Weigh-ups average. Slaughter cows 1.00-2.00-higher. Slaughter bulls firm. Packer demand good for lighter numbers. Total of 300 cows and bulls sold, with about 85 percent going to packers. Receipts this week 7,800; last week 12,550; last year 4,442. Supply consisted of 67 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 29 percent calves under 600 lbs; 4 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis. 

