Compared to Monday of last week: Feeder cattle and calves over 600 lbs 2.00-3.00 lower. Lighter weight calves steady. Demand light to moderate for feeders; moderate for calves. Demand best for cold weather breeds in thin flesh. Quality of supply average to attractive. Flesh conditions in wide range of thin to moderately fleshy. Often times excess flesh attributed to feed rather than graze and this acquiring additional discounts. Weigh condition average. Slaughter cows and bulls steady. Demand from packers moderate. Demand light for replacement cows during this rather lengthy arctic freeze. 520 cows and bulls sold with about 75 percent to packers. Receipts this week 10,750; last week 7,822; last year 6,965. Supply consisted of 64 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs; 31 percent calves under 600 lbs; 5 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
