

Hatfield Announces Payment Changes

Effective Feb. 26, the double discount for hogs grading below Hatfield's base of 56% lean cuts will be eliminated. Discounts will now be valued at the same level as premiums.

In addition, to address customers' requests for a more uniform and consistent product, Hatfield will be adjusting the sort penalty for hogs significantly outside the desired weight range.

The weight categories immediately outside the desired range remain unaffected. Hatfield will continue to maintain one of the widest desired weight ranges in the industry.

These changes are viewed by Hatfield as positive steps toward providing greater returns for Hatfield's hog producers.

In addition to club business, awards are also to be presented including the Dr. Hoopes and John Stiles memorial awards.

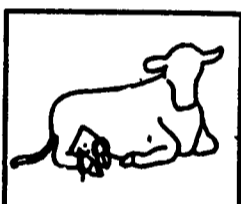
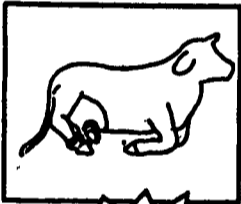

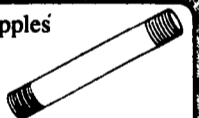

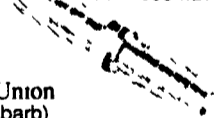

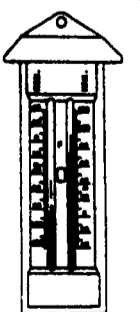
