"Pennsylvania ranks fifth nationally in apple production," Brosius said. "With increased resources, the Apple Marketing Program can work to enter new markets, including export markets.'

The referendum proposes to change the rate of assessment beginning with the 1996-97 marketing season to 12 cents per bushel of apples sold for fresh market use and six cents per hundred pounds of apples sold or accepted for processing.

Beginning with the 2000-01 marketing season, the proposed rate of assessment would increase to 15 cents per bushel of apples sold for fresh market use and eight cents per hundred pounds of apples sold or accepted for processing.

The proposed amendment applies to all apple growers in the Commonwealth with five hundred or more apple trees of all ages.

The referendum period will begin on March 25, 1996, and will end at 4 p.m. on April 8, 1996.
